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Foreword

This is the first volume in ICU Linguistics, which includes selected papers from a field methods course offered at International Christian University in 2016. The course particularly focused on Zulu language, a language spoken in the Republic of South Africa. In this course, a native Zulu consultant provided us with a lot of data of the language.

The papers in this volume report original findings of the Zulu language. One of the five papers is phonetics, two are on phonology, and the other two are syntax papers. One of the authors is an exchange student from University of Albert in the US, and the other four are ICU undergraduate students.

The authors came up with the topics by themselves, as they learned about Zulu language alongside of linguistic phenomena. They also conducted the elicitation sessions, and the articulated data were recorded as well as transcribed. This first volume of ICU papers in Linguistics shows what one can investigate in an undergraduate field methods course.

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
